

Georgia Compensatory Educational Leaders, Inc. Scholarship Application 2021

The Georgia Compensatory Educational Leaders (GCEL), Inc. Scholarship is designed for high school seniors who will attend an institution of higher education (4-year college or technical college) in the Fall of 2021. GCEL Inc. will award four (4) scholarships valued at \$1,500 per student. Applicants must be enrolled as a senior in a Georgia Title I High School for the 2020-2021 year. Scholarship application must be <u>postmarked by Friday</u>, February 20, 2021. Late or incomplete applications will not be reviewed. For additional information, please visit <u>www.gcel.org</u>.

SCHOLARSHIP REVIEW GUIDELINES

1. Applicant must provide the following information in order to demonstrate eligibility for the GCEL Inc. Scholarship:

- A. Submit verification of enrollment as a senior in a Georgia Title I School for the 2020-2021 school year from a school official,
- B. Submit official high school transcript in a <u>sealed envelope</u> showing a grade point average of 2.5 or higher,
- C. Submit one teacher recommendation (in a sealed envelope),
- D. Submit one community member or an elder known to the family recommendation(in a sealed envelope),
- E. Submit an essay between 500 to 1000 words stating future goals (Item 11 on scholarship application), and
- F. Submit proof of acceptance of enrollment to a college, university, or technical school <u>no later than</u> <u>September 30, 2021</u>.

2. Submit completed scholarship application with applicable signatures
